FOOD DELIVERY TO TEN (10) SENIORS WITH GROVELAND BAPTIST CHURCH IN BIRMINGHAM

We made a delivery of food to ten (10) senior citizens with Groveland Baptist Church. The eight (8) volunteers put in over 8 hours, over two days to unload, sort, bag and load groceries. I have never met any team of people who were harder working or who showed such dedication to helping their seniors. The experience was uplifting and enervating; but, the people that were there to help made the process easy and fun.

The food and household items given out are sufficient to supply the seniors for 3-4 weeks.
