Welcome Home Mrs. W!

In July 2024, a 60-year widow, Mrs. W. had a triple bypass. Before her surgery, Heart in Hands and volunteers from DAV partnered with us to do a total home modification for her. We put in over 150 man-hours in order to make it more accessible and provide

cosmetic upgrades. Before and after photos are at the end of the newsletter.

The following work was performed:

☐ The Interior of the House was Painted.

90% of the painting labor was provided by two volunteers from DAV, Ladell Amison and Derrick Rome. The senior's son also painted trim work, baseboards and the bathroom. Deborah Harrison painted the hallway and the den.

☐ Donation of Appliances

Heart in Hands donated a new water heater, (and its installation), a refrigerator and sink cabinet for the bathroom.

☐ Safety and Security Work

Heart in Hands totally rebuilt the laundry room floor, that had rotted out due to a leak from the broken washing machine. There were areas where you could see the ground beneath the house.

Rats were coming into the house through the holes in the floor. Heart in Hands also paid to have the house sprayed for mice and roaches.

☐ Furniture, Fixtures, bedding, and linen

Deborah Harrison donated bedroom furniture for the master and a guest bedroom, living room tables, drapes for all rooms in the house, linens for the beds, a TV cabinet, blinds, and oriental rug for the den, pictures, decorative items for all rooms, and a bench for the master bedroom.

A new leather chair and ottoman were donated by Heart in Hands




